2017 Contest Rules

- 1) Gingerbread houses must be constructed only from hand-made gingerbread. Houses made from kits, graham crackers, or similar construction materials will not be accepted.
- 2) Any decorations must be edible, unwrapped, and preferably hand-made.
- 3) Entries cannot contain canned or packaged commercial icings, creams, or frostings.
- 4) Entries cannot use electric power, candles, or heat-producing features.
- 5) Houses must be mounted on a base that is sturdy enough to facilitate carrying and moving the entry. **The base can be no larger than 29 inches in any dimension. Entries that exceed these dimensions will be disqualified.**
- 6) Because the exhibit continues for several weeks, staff will not provide repairs. Entrants will be notified if their structure needs repairs.

Entries will be accepted Monday, Nov. 27 through Saturday, Dec. 2, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Ferry Farm.

Ribbons awarded Sunday, Dec. 3 by 12:00 noon.

Exhibit opens to the public on Dec. 3 at noon.

All entrants and their guests are invited to a reception, Sunday, Dec. 3 at 2:00 p.m. Entrants will have an opportunity to tell their Stafford story on video if they would like to share.

Each entrant will receive three free tickets to the exhibit.

Entry Levels

- 1) Age 2-5 (with adult supervision)
- 2) Age 6-10 (with adult supervision)
- 3) Age 11-14 (working alone)
- 4) Age 15-17 (working alone)
- 5) Age 18 and over
- 6) Family made
- 7) Special needs
- 8) Professional: One who receives payment for food services

Awards

First- through third-place ribbons will be awarded at each level. A plaque suitable for wall mounting will be awarded to the first-place finisher in the Professional level.
